How PST Players Accumulate Points

(Updated for 2011-2012 season)

Points are cumulative throughout the season (August – April) and are reset at the beginning of the following season.

Players earn points for each match they win in a tournament. They also earn points in a losing match for every rally they win. This ensures that fans see a player's best effort on every rally. It also rewards players with more points when they lose a very close match as opposed to a lopsided loss.

Base Tournament Points

Main Draw

- 140 points awarded per win in the main draw.
- 2 points awarded per point (rally) won in a loss.

Qualifying Draw and 3rd Place Match

- 70 points awarded per win
- 1 point awarded per point (rally) won in a loss

As purse money increases, more players are attracted to the tournament. Therefore, match points are subject to a multiplier. The following multipliers will apply to matches in the following purse categories.

Prize Money	Multiplier
< \$ 1,000	1.0
\$ 1,000 - \$ 2,499	1.5
\$ 2,500 - \$ 4,999	2.0
\$ 5,000 - \$ 9,999	3.0
\$10,000 - \$19,999	4.0
\$20,000 +	5.0
